**BANKNOTES**



The 2018 Series Hong Kong Banknotes are issued by The Hongkong and Shanghai Banking Corporation Limited, Standard Chartered Bank (Hong Kong) Limited and Bank of China (Hong Kong) Limited. This is the first time that the three note-issuing banks unified the thematic subject on the reverse side of the same banknote denominations, and used a vertically-oriented layout for the reverse side of the banknotes for aesthetic presentation of the thematic subject and differentiation from previous series.

The selected thematic subjects represent different aspects of Hong Kong as an international metropolis, featuring its rhythm of life, recreation and entertainment, as well as its rich natural and cultural heritage. The five denominations depict respectively the position of Hong Kong as international financial centre (HK\$1,000), the spectacular Hong Kong UNESCO Global Geopark (HK\$500), Cantonese opera as our art and cultural legacy (HK\$100), butterflies that inhabit Hong Kong (HK\$50), and the popular dim sum and tea culture (HK\$20).

The old series banknotes remain legal tender and will continue to circulate along with the 2018 Series.

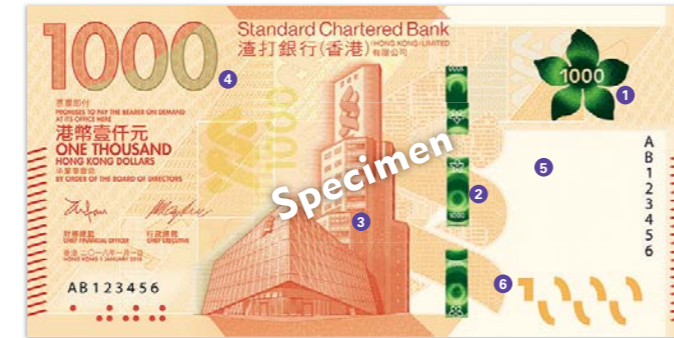

### TILTING



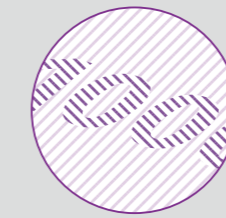
#### Dynamic Shimmering Pattern

When the note is tilted, the shimmering ring in the pattern moves correspondingly.

#### 2 Windowed Metallic Thread



When the note is tilted, the large and small rings on the metallic thread move correspondingly.



#### 3 Concealed Denomination

When the note is tilted under the light, the denomination numeral hidden in the background can be seen.

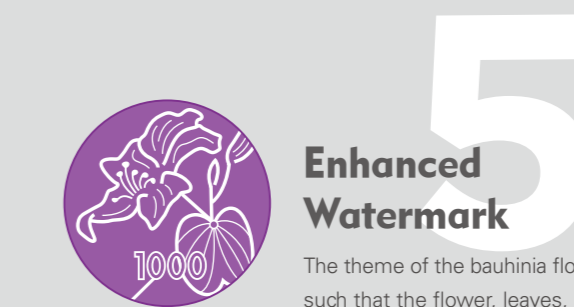
### TOUCHING



#### 4 Embossed Feel

Raised printing gives the note a strong embossed feel by touch.

### VIEWING



#### 5 Enhanced Watermark

The theme of the bauhinia flower is used such that the flower, leaves, bud and denomination numeral can be seen when the note is held up to the light.

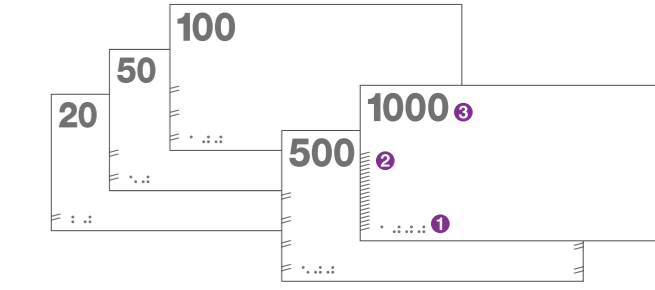


#### 6 Fluorescent See-through Denomination

The patterns on the front and back, which are of a single colour under normal light, will appear as two fluorescent colours when exposed to ultraviolet light. The patterns on the front and back fit perfectly to form the denomination numeral when the note is held up to the light.

The 2018 Series Banknotes are equipped with braille, tactile lines and high-tactility numerals. The visually impaired can also use a note-measuring template to identify the denomination of a banknote.

### Note-measuring Template

The note-measuring template helps the visually impaired identify the denomination by measuring the length of a note. This device is available for free distribution through voluntary agencies serving the visually impaired community.
