2. a platform for exchanging ideas of innovative fintech initiatives among key stakeholders and conducting outreaching activities;
3. an interface between market participants and regulators within the HKMA; and
4. a facilitator to nurture talents to meet the growing needs of fintech in Hong Kong.

Job Duties:

To support the various functions of the Fintech Facilitation Office in

- Conducting research into Fintech and its impacts, and reporting to management on issues. The range of research may include;
 - a. Policy research on Fintech including international developments;
 - b. Fintech ecosystem developments across different jurisdictions;
 - c. Legal and regulatory implications in using and implementing Fintech;
 - d. Proof of Concept studies and technical research work (such as CBDC, AI, data analytics and visualisation, open API etc.) on Fintech.
- Assisting in the organisation of Fintech events and outreach programmes;
- Assisting in production of marketing collaterals including but not limited to presentation decks and animation videos to promote Fintech ecosystem;
