Mr Kwok has been an Honorary Senior Research Fellow in the Faculty of Business and Economics of the University of Hong Kong since November 2008 and has been the AsiaGlobal Fellows Program Director of the Asia Global Institute since March 2018.

He was an Independent Non-Executive Director of DBS Bank (Hong Kong) Ltd. (2012 – 2020), the Government Economist of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (HKSAR) Government (2004 – 2008) and the Regional Chief Economist of Standard Chartered Bank for East Asia (1991 – 2004).
