Banknotes in Hong Kong: 2002 Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government ten-dollar note

On 1 July 2002, the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region Government issued a banknote for the first time. The abstract design of this ten-dollar banknote combines the elements of modern architecture in Hong Kong with Chinese festive and cultural activities.

The main colour of earlier ten-dollar notes in Hong Kong was green and these notes were about the size of a crab. They were therefore affectionately known as "green crabs" in the local community. "Green crabs" were often used for *lai sees* – gifts of money given in red envelopes at Chinese New Year.

Issuance of ten-dollar notes in Hong Kong had ceased since 1995.
However, a new ten-dollar note was introduced in 2002 in response to popular demand. With its mauve, purple, blue and yellow design, this new ten-dollar note has quickly earned itself a nickname of "colourful crab".
